The Queen's carbon tax is designed to kill

“Forget about the carbon tax hurting your wallet—it’s going to kill you,” Citizens Electoral Council leader Craig Isherwood declared today.

Mr Isherwood scorned economic modelling that showed the carbon tax would cost families \$860 per year, or \$16 per week.

“The issue is not so much that it will cost money,” he said. “The issue is that it will kill the economy, by crippling baseload electricity generation, agriculture and manufacturing, without which people can not live. It will give us a Third World economy and the corresponding Third World life expectancy.

“Already now, pensioners are suffering hyperthermia and heat stroke and thousands have died because they can not afford to heat or cool their homes. These numbers will only skyrocket with such proposed energy cuts.

“It’s designed to kill people,” he insisted. “The Queen herself ordered the members of the Commonwealth at CHOGM in 2009 to lead the world on climate change action, such as pricing carbon, to achieve the British Crown’s strategic policy, oft-stated by her husband, of global population reduction.

“Or as Julia Gillard’s fellow Fabian Society member and sustainable population fanatic Kelvin Thomson puts it in the newspeak of climate change, we can’t reduce our carbon footprint without reducing the number of footprints.”

Mandating 20 per cent “renewable” energy by 2020, while banning nuclear power, will drive Australia into a dark age, Mr Isherwood said.

“Renewable energy is a fraud—solar panels and

wind turbines can’t generate enough energy to make solar panels and wind turbines,” he scoffed.

“Consumers may get compensation for the carbon tax they pay, but they won’t get reliable electricity.”

He explained, “A living standard is not based on money; it is based on the availability of energy, food, health care, education, infrastructure and essential services.

“Australia’s ability to guarantee those things has already been mostly destroyed by more than twenty years of another British Crown policy—the free market, pushed by right wing think tanks associated with the Crown-funded Mont Pelerin Society; what hasn’t been destroyed, now the carbon tax will finish off.”

Mr Isherwood called on Australians to get behind the CEC’s fight to throw out the genocidal policies of the British Crown, and revitalise the Australian economy for the benefit of the people.

“Australia must go back to being a high-technology economy, with a commitment to real science and industry,” he said.

“We must take advantage of our abundant natural resources of uranium and thorium, and go nuclear; we should launch a space

program; we need a high-speed magnetically-levitated train network connecting all of our major cities; we need great water projects that can transform the arid interior of Australia the way irrigation transformed the Murray-Darling Basin, into new food bowls to feed the world.

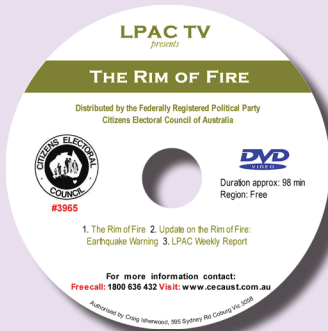
“Join the CEC’s fight to achieve this vision for Australia,” he urged.

Isherwood on government funding of greens: “Cut it out!”

Responding to revelations that the main green groups in Australia which front Prince Philip’s genocidal depopulation agenda and which are the chief proponents for a “carbon tax”, have received an astounding \$10 million in federal and state government funding over the past five years, Citizens Electoral Council leader Craig Isherwood demanded, “I want my money back!”

Some of the relevant essentials were reported in the 19th-20th March *The Weekend Australian*: Prince Philip’s own Australian Conservation Foundation, which he founded in 1963 and nurtured for many years as its president, has pocketed \$2.9m over the past five years, while other recipients include Environment Victoria (over \$4 million), Total Environment Centre (\$450,000), the Wilderness Society (\$125,000), and the eco-fascist Friends of the Earth (\$65,000). Curiously, *The Weekend Australian* neglected to mention that the Australian branch of Prince Philip’s World Wide Fund for Nature also receives millions of dollars of government funding every year.

The Weekend Australian’s belated revelations are only the tip of the iceberg, because Federal and State governments have lavishly financed these genocidal green groups for decades. For instance, the ACF is supposedly a “private” foundation, but it only got off the ground in the 1960s because the Federal Government poured in hundreds of thousands of dollars (i.e. millions in today’s equivalent) to get them going, while in the late 1980s Graham Richardson as Environment Minister in the Hawke government funnelled public money to the same green groups. In fact, without that financial and other Federal support, the Australian Greens likely would never have emerged in the first place, while the 19th March revelations by this Rupert Murdoch rag have much the smell of a whore screaming “Rape!”, given that his paper has honoured Greens honcho Bob Brown as “Australian of the Year”. Mr Isherwood accused the federal and state governments of financing genocide:

“Prince Philip and his Nazi eugenicist cronies launched the green movement to achieve one goal—eliminating most of the world’s human population”, he charged.

“He openly fantasises about being reincarnated as a deadly virus to create a pandemic to mass-murder people; he compares human beings to herds of sheep, who need to be ‘culled’ so they don’t exceed their carrying capacity; his ACF wants human population growth to be legally classified as a ‘key threatening

process’ to native biodiversity, the same category as cane toads and feral cats; his ACF spawned Sustainable Population Australia, which openly wants to reduce the number of Australians, through a Chinese-style ‘one child’ policy and racist immigration restrictions that stop people from developing countries immigrating to Australia; and his ideological love-child, Professor Tim Flannery, who is a trustee of his World Wide Fund for Nature and a Patron of Sustainable Population Australia, has demanded that Australia’s population be slashed to as few as six million people.

“These are the very groups and individuals which have relentlessly campaigned to shut down our national food bowl, the Murray-Darling Basin, and to destroy our food security.”

Mr Isherwood continued, “Only an idiot could not see the obvious: that Prince Philip’s green movement is not a ‘grass-roots movement of the people’, but a fascist force deployed by an oligarchical elite, wielding political power far greater than its actual support among the population because it is government-funded to begin with—as global warming advocate Murdoch now belatedly reveals in an attempt to corral the growing mass strike against British imperial genocide.

“Where are the regulations for this kind of funding?” he demanded. “What should apply here is truth-in-labelling laws, so the ACF are forced to declare that their policies will kill people. It’s mandatory for cigarettes, so why not the ACF? After all, their policies will assuredly kill millions.” He concluded, “Governments that conspire against their own populations should be held to the Nuremberg standard of crimes against humanity. If the various state and federal governments don’t like to hear that, they should stop funding these genocidalists.”
