

STOP MI5/MI6-RUN TERRORISM

Crown's MI5 set to 'investigate' far-Right extremists

The UK's domestic spy agency MI5 is now tasked with tackling the terror threat from "far-Right extremists", a role previously conducted by police. This change, described by the Daily Mail as "part of a major shake-up", means far-Right ideology will sit in the same Security Service portfolio as Islamist and Irish terrorism. But the overwhelming evidence, as documented in the CEC's 2017 pamphlet Stop MI5/MI6-run Terrorism!, is that far from stopping terrorism, British intelligence agencies have long orchestrated it. This MI5 takeover of policing raises the spectre of establishment-manufactured far-Right terrorism as a cover for the City of London-centred financial oligarchy in the face of a now-imminent global financial meltdown. Such a climate of chaos would create the conditions for assassinations, and an excuse to suppress genuine political opposition under the cover of stopping extremism.


In October Max Hill QC, the UK government's "independent" reviewer of terror legislation, reported that the threat from extreme right-wing terrorism is now "considerable". White people in the UK make up the largest proportion of arrested terrorism suspects for the first time in 13 years. The proportion of suspects recorded as white by the arresting officer increased by four percentage points to 38 per cent in the year to 30 June, while those recorded as ethnically Asian fell by seven percentage points to 37 per cent. The proportion recorded as black fell by two points to 9 per cent, Home Office statistics show. UK authorities have expressed fears about a resurgence of neo-Nazi groups, especially since the murder of Labour MP Jo Cox by white supremacist Thomas Mair in 2016. In February, Darren Osborne was jailed for life for a vehicle-ramming attack on Muslim worshippers in Finsbury Park, London, in June 2017, which killed one and injured at least nine others.

This move should raise fear that MI5 is going to turbocharge far-Right terrorism, in the same way the agency is complicit in Islamist terrorism in the UK. As documented in authoritative books including The Suicide Factory: Abu Hamza and the Finsbury Park Mosque, by Sean O'Neill and Daniel McGrory, and Secret Affairs: Britain's Collusion with Radical Islam, by former Chatham House analyst Mark Curtis, MI5 is notorious for its "covenant of security" with known terrorist groups, under which MI5 allowed them to live and operate in the UK, and even plan terrorist attacks, as long as they did not commit attacks on British soil. It is claimed that this policy was ended soon after the 9/11 terrorist attack in 2001, but as late as 2016 British police continued to complain that MI5 actively blocked their policing of Islamist extremists. The two most prominent terrorist recruiters in the UK, Abu Hamza and Anjem Choudary, who are both implicated in numerous UK terrorist attacks, including the 7/7 subway bombing in 2005, the public beheading of Lee Rigby in 2013 and the London Bridge attack in 2017, are both tied to MI5, Abu Hamza admitting in court that he was an MI5 agent.

British state-sponsored terrorism

Author Anne Cadwallader meticulously documented British state-sponsored terrorism in her book *Lethal Allies*:

British Collusion in Ireland, providing incontrovertible evidence of collusion between loyalist paramilitaries and the state in dozens of murders in Northern Ireland during the period of "The Troubles" (1968-98). According to the release issued for her Australian book tour in 2015, "Using previously confidential police reports, British declassified documents and eve-witness accounts, the book establishes beyond



any doubt that London colluded in the murders of more than 120 Catholic civilians in Ireland."

The BBC Panorama documentary *Britain's Secret Terror Deals* (2015) expanded the story still further, exposing the intelligence agencies which protected "state-sponsored serial killers" on both sides of The Troubles. In a May 2015 press release, Amnesty International's Northern Ireland Programme Director Patrick Corrigan said: "There must now be a full, independent investigation into the scale of the policy where the police, army and MI5 worked with illegal paramilitary groups, resulting in the deaths of perhaps hundreds of people."

The Crown sits at the head of this state-sponsored terrorism, with Prince Charles as Royal Patron of the Intelligence Services. As foreign intelligence agency MI6 states on its website: "The Prince of Wales became Royal Patron of the Intelligence Agencies in 2011 following a recommendation from all three chiefs of MI5, MI6 and GCHQ [Government Communications Headquarters, Britain's signals intelligence agency] in recognition of his longstanding and close support for their work in this country and overseas." And as documented in *Stop MI5/MI6-run Terrorism!*, several Board Members and financiers of Prince Charles's Oxford Centre for Islamic Studies are Saudi agents implicated in terrorism, including the 9/11 attacks in the USA.

Suppressing political opposition

The Crown-City of London financial oligarchy fears political opposition that might overthrow its power. Labour Leader Jeremy Corbyn, who will likely be the next Prime Minister, is accordingly under incredible attack, including under the guise of opposing terrorism. US lawyer Alan Dershowitz is backing an investigation into whether Corbyn should face US sanctions as a supporter of terrorism, reported *The Times*, an establishment mouthpiece, on 28 October. Such ludicrous charges are a sign of the oligarchy's desperation.
